

Use a tableau to test this argument for logical correctness.

1. Anyone who understands human nature is clever.
2. Noone is a true poet unless he can stir the hearts of men.
3. Shakespeare wrote Hamlet.
4. Noone who doesn't understand human nature can stir the hearts of men.
5. Noone but a true poet could have written Hamlet.
6. Therefore, Shakespeare is clever.

Use the following propositional language.

a = able to stir the hearts of men

c = clever

s = Shakespeare

p = true poet

u = understands human nature

w = writer of Hamlet
