- 2. Noone is a true poet unless he can stir the hearts of men.
- 3. Shakespeare wrote Hamlet.
- 4. Noone who doesn't understand human nature can stir the hearts of men.
- 5. Noone but a true poet could have written Hamlet.
- 6. Therefore, Shakespeare is clever.

Use the following propositional language.

- a = able to stir the hearts of men
- c = clever
- s = Shakespeare
- p = true poet
- u = understands human nature
- w = writer of Hamlet
